WILD Crafts: Moon Bear Refrigerator Magnets

Materials:

Black construction paper
White paper
4 inch piece of Magnetic tape
Scissors
Glue Stick
Tacky Glue
Pencil
1 Pair of googly eyes
1 medium black pompom
1 CD
1 Coffee cup
1 white crayon

Directions:

1. With the pencil trace the outer edge of the CD disc to be the bear's body and the coffee cup to be the bear's head and cut out both circles.
2. With the pencil draw out two 2 inch ovals for the bear's feet, two 3 inch circles for the bear's ears, and two 5 inch banana shapes all on black paper.
3. Cut out the 2 inch ovals, the 3 inch circles, and the 5 inch banana shapes.
4. On the white paper draw and cut out a small 2 inch crescent shape.
5. Glue an ear on each side of the bear's head with the glue stick.
6. Glue the Googly eyes to the bear's head with the glue stick.
7. Glue the Black pompom nose to the bear's head with the tacky glue.
8. Glue the Bear head to the top of the bear body with the glue stick.
9. Glue an arm to each side of the bear's body with the glue stick.
10. Glue on the white crescent shape pointy ends down on the bear's chest with the glue stick.
11. At the bottom of the bear's body glue on the two 2 inch ovals for the bear's feet with the glue stick.
12. With the white crayon, personalize your bear adding a mouth on the bear's face and toes on the bear's feet.
13. Attach the magnetic tape to the back of the moon bear to use as a magnet
