School Programs Internship Position Description

POSTION TITLE: School Programs Internship

CLASSIFICATION: Intern (unpaid)
DEPARTMENT: Education

REPORTS TO: Manager of School Programs

Summary of Responsibilities:

The School Programs Internship is designed for people interested in informal science education. School Programs Interns are supervised and mentored by School Programs staff. Under the direct guidance of the School Programs staff, interns will learn how to promote a positive learning environment for students involved in the Zoo's afterschool programs. Through the observation of School Programs Staff, mentorship of a School Programs Specialist and development and implementation of a lesson, interns will learn the skills necessary to pursue a career in the informal science education field. This is a volunteer position. It is unpaid and there is no housing provided.

Essential Position Functions:

- 1. Operating under the close supervision of School Programs staff members, interns will learn and be evaluated on how to assist with preparation, implementation and facilitation of programs that promote environmental education and are aligned to school standards.
- 2. Under the guidance of the School Programs mentor, develop and implement a lesson for an afterschool program.
- 3. Learn how to build and maintain a professional rapport with the students involved in Zoo programs while maintaining a safe, positive environment.
- 4. Participate in weekly check-ins with School Programs mentor which will include reflection and feedback.

Qualifications:

- 1. Must be at least 18 years old. Age verification may be required due to monitored supervision and teaching of minor children.
- 2. Completion of at least one year of related college-level coursework or demonstrate relevant experience.
- 3. Must demonstrate willingness to learn about preparation, implementation and facilitation of programs that promote environmental education.
- 4. Ability to:
 - pass a background check upon selection as an intern,
 - commit to two afternoons a week for a minimum of 12 weeks,
 - work independently, as well as part of a team,
 - follow all instructions, verbal and written.
- 5. Effectively support the mission and priorities of Roger Williams Park Zoo.
- 6. Adhere to all policies described in the Roger Williams Park Zoo's Volunteer Handbook.
- 7. Experience working with youth preferred.
