Responsibilities:

- Troubleshooting related to sound, lighting, and videos and computer-related functional processes.
- Setup and breakdown of sound, lighting, video, and related equipment for all zoo events.
- Maintenance of equipment checkout systems, ensuring any equipment used is returned to its proper location.
- Maintain inventory of all sound, lighting, video and related equipment.
- Prioritize daily work assignments.
- Ensure all equipment is maintained in good working order and schedule equipment repair as needed.

High school diploma plus one year's experience in a professional AV Technology environment or equivalent of education and experience required.

Preferred Experience and Education:

Recent experience working with diverse populations and fluency speaking additional languages a plus.
